Energy Audits/Design Assistance

This is a great starting point for you to identify major energy-saving opportunities for your business and facility. Agralite Electric Cooperative offers two types of energy audits, both designed to help lower your energy costs. A free basic walk-through audit provides general information on efficiency improvements and programs. A cost-share audit is a comprehensive electric audit completed by an engineering professional.

Compressed Air

If your business uses a compressed air system, rebates and incentives are available for the evaluation of the system and for equipment upgrades or system improvement that result in lower energy use. This is a great way to improve your system and decrease energy consumption.

Geothermal Heat Pumps

Geothermal (ground-source) heat pumps are three to four times more efficient than standard furnaces, plus in addition to heating, they cool your building. A rebate is available for using this technology. The Department of Energy and the Environmental Protection Agency endorse geothermal heat pumps as among the most efficient and environmentally friendly heating and cooling system options available.

Cooling — Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC)

Does your business use cooling equipment? The cooling rebate programs provide rebates when you purchase or replace equipment with qualifying commercial cooling equipment. The higher the efficiency, the more rebate you receive!

Did you know lighting often accounts for over 40% of your energy bill? Rebates are available for lighting retrofit projects, new construction, and new lighting projects.

New and Retrofit Premium Efficiency Motors/ASPs

You likely have many various motors in your business. By purchasing or replacing motors with efficient motors you could be eligible for a rebate. Agralite Electric Cooperative offers rebates for motors which meet the National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) Premium Efficiency Motor Standards.

Wellspring Wind Energy

Time to go green? Lots of consumer's are starting think about their personal carbon footprint and choose businesses and services based on

their environmental footprint. Agralite Electric Cooperative is proactive in the support of wind power and, along with Great River Energy, was the first utility in the five-state region to offer a "green pricing program."

Green pricing is an optional service that allows customers an opportunity to support a greater level of investment in renewable energy technologies. Participating members pay a small premium on their electric bills to cover the incremental cost of the additional renewable energy. Wellspring's renewable energy supply is certified by the Minnesota Office of Energy and Security.

Agriculture

Several rebates and incentives are available for agricultural businesses. Some of the various installations that have rebates and incentives are compressor heat recovery systems, plate and frame-type milk pre-coolers, lighting and NEMA premium efficient motors.

Low pressure irrigation is another application that is specific to Agriculture. Any irrigator installing a new irrigation system or retrofitting an existing system to low pressure may be eligible for a rebate to help cover the cost of the added cost of going low pressure.

Any program that applies to commercial and industrial accounts is also available to any agricultural account.
