- 1. This opportunity is only available for students whose parent/legal guardians receive electricity from Agralite Electric Cooperative. The Rural Electric Youth Tour is a benefit of co-op membership.
- 2. Must be a high school junior or senior during the 2024 school year.
- 3. Must be available to participate in the dates and full schedule of the Youth Tour in Washington, D.C., which is June 18-23, 2024.
- 4. Must be able to ride in a vehicle or bus for up to 12 hours (with breaks) in a single day.
- 5. Must be able to fly in an airplane and provide a valid Minnesota driver's license or Minnesota state-issued ID card.
- 6. Must agree to be photographed while on the Youth Tour, and must grant permission for cooperative use in publications, social media, websites, media, etc.
- 7. Applicant may be invited to present at the Agralite Electric Cooperative Annual Meeting to recap their Youth Tour experiences and gained knowledge of electric cooperatives.

• If an unforeseen situation happens and I am not able to fulfill my obligation to attend, I must notify Agralite Electric Cooperative before March 31 so an alternate may be considered.
